

HOW TO FIND US

As the most significant continental hub for German, European and Intercontinental Flights, Rhein-Main-Airport is only a short drive away from “Main Tower”. From the Airport, all major European cities can be reached within 1-3 hours flight time. All Germany’s major cities are also accessible through scores of train connections from the closely located Frankfurt Hauptbahnhof (main station) and in most cases, via Germany’s modern high-speed ICE Trains.

Directions

From Airport

- After landing, head to the “DB-Regionalbahnhof” (regional trains) in Terminal 1.
- Take the “S-Bahn” train headed to Frankfurt (lines **S8**-Hanau or **S9**-Offenbach Ost).
- Get off at “**Taunusanlage**” Station (journey should take around 15 minutes).
- Alternatively, you can also take a taxi directly from the Airport to Main Tower.

By Rail

- From the Hauptbahnhof (central station), take an “S-Bahn” Train (lines **S1** to **S9**).
- Travel one stop to “**Taunusanlage**” Station.

By Car

- If approaching Frankfurt from the west, take the motorway **A66**, and exit at **Miquelallee**.
- From the east, take the motorway **A3**.
- From north or south, drive on motorway **A5** in the direction of Westkreuz (motorway interchange), at Westkreuz turn onto the **A648** in the direction of Frankfurt.
- From all directions follow signs to “Frankfurt/Innenstadt/Messe” (city centre/fair and exhibition centre) and then to **Hauptbahnhof**.
- Turn left into **Mainzer Landstraße** and then right into **Junghofstraße** where public parking facilities are available (see opposite map).
